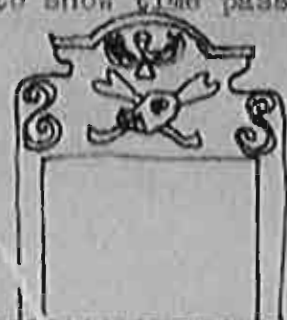

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS)

Millward p. 855, tomb 568 for west side only.

West side: Here lyeth the body of / Gillam SCOTT the son of Thomas / and Mary SCOTT / mason and citizen of London and of this parish / who departed this life on ye 27th day of June 1735 / in the third year of his age /

Also here lies the body of Millet SCOTT late / daughter of the above said / who departed this life / on the 1st day of January 1737 in the 4th year of her age /

Here also lies the body of Mrs Margaret GILLAM / mother to the above Mary SCOTT / who died April 20 1750 aged 81 years /

East side: Here lyeth the body of / Thomas SCOTT the son of Thomas / and Mary SCOTT remembered on the / other side of this stone / who departed this life Oct ... / in the 30 year of his age / Afflictions sore long time I bore / Physicians were in vain / Till God did please to give me ease / and free me from my pain / Also the body of Mr Thomas SCOTT / father of the above /
