**INSCRIPTIONS** (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 865, tomb 573

North side: Beneath this stone / were deposited April 15 1823 the beloved remains/of / Elizabeth, youngest daughter of Sir James MACKINTOSH / who departed this life on the 9th of the same month / aged 19 years /

Here also, within the tomb of her dear child, hopes to rest / & through the mercy of her Redeemer to rise with her to that / life everlasting in which they shall be no more separated / her afflicted mother who inscribed this tablet /

In the same grave lies / her infant brother / Robert / who died April 1803 /

South side: Underneath this stone / lie the remains of / the Rt. Hon. Sir James MACKINTOSH / born at Aldourie Invernesshire 24 Oct. 1763 / died in London 30 May 1832 / Also of his grandson James Mackintosh WEDGEWOOD / born 23 April 1834 died 24 June 1864 /

And Hensleigh Arskine / born 4th Oct. 1835 died 15 April 1836 / the sons of Hensleigh WEDGEWOOD and Frances Emma / daughter of Sir James MACKINTOSH /

West side: In memory of / Catherine / wife of / Sir James MACKINTOSH / and daughter of / John Hensleigh ALLAN / of Cresselly, Pembrokehire / who died in Switzerland / 6th May 18

Top: Here also repose / the mortal remains of / Frances Emma / daughter of Sir James MACKINTOSH / ... /.../ born October ... died ... /

Hensleigh WEDGEWOOD / born January ...
