Top: Here lieth the body of / Mr John Vincent / late of this parish / who died April 8th 1719 / aged 55 years / Here lieth the body of Sarah / his wife who died Nov. 17th - / in the 46th yr of her age [not indistinct] / Also the body of Sarah his wife / eldest daughter and co-heiress / of Mr Richard Cowper / of London gent / who she died Nov 22 1765 / aged 78 / Here lieth the remains of Richard Vincent / of the Inver Esq. barrister at law / and son of John & Sarah Vincent / He departed this life [Temple] Jan 7 1776 / aged 57 / Also Robert Vincent Esq. / youngest son of J & S Vincent / who died 2 Aug. 1786 / aged 57 yrs

N. side: Here lies (sic) the bodies of / Lewis Schuman / of London merchant / who died May 6 / 1769 aged 59 / Also of Sarah his wife daughter of the last above John and Sarah Vincent / She died Aug 5 1767 aged 45 yrs South side: Here also lies ye body of / John Vincent jun. / 2nd son of ye last above / John Vincent / who died March 18 1754 / aged 33 yrs
