

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 852, tomb 563

N. side: Beneath are deposited the remains of John GODFREY elder son of William and Susannah GODFREY of / ... Green in the parish of Paddington in this county. He died on the 7th October 1756 aged 23 years /

Also the remains of the said Susannah GODFREY who died on the 17th day of / December 1759 aged 60 years. Her life was an amiable triumph of conjugal virtue / accompanied with a resignation becoming a good and faithful servant / enter into the joy of the Lord /

Below here are deposited the remains of the abovesaid William GODFREY Esq. one of / His Majesty's Justices of the Peace for this county who died on the 21st March 1766 aged 68 years / .. with a strong natural genius and a very retentive memory .

His observations / were ... experience. He was therefore frequently referred to in most parts of / ... with great candour judgement and precision this / ... by industry and are the more likely to prosper as they went hand / in hand with integrity. Go and do likewise.

(The above is not recorded by Millward. He given the MI below, which cannot now be found.)

"Altar: Sacred to the memory of Mrs/Susannah GODFREY / of Brockley Hill Middlesex who departed this life / on the 18 of July, 1815 / aged 70 years /

Also William GODFREY Esq / of the same place / who died 27 March 1826 / aged 88 years /
