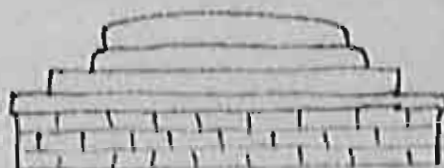

On vertical face, E. end, ledger stone: Dame Johanna Watson's family vault.

On top of ledger stone: Within this vault are deposited / the remains of Dame Johanna / late widow of Sir James Watson K^t / late one of the Judges of the / supreme court of Judicature at Bengal / who died May 6th 1811 aged 57 years /

Also the remains of Mary Susannah / daughter of the above / and the beloved wife of Robert Smith / surgeon of Sloane Street / who died June 22 1814 aged 30 years /

Also Margaretta Johanna / eldest daughter of the above / Dame Johanna / and wife of / Col. Robt. Armstrong / of the Bengal Native Cavalry / who died Jany. 25th 1837 aged 57 years /

Also the remains of / Arabella Watson / who died November 14 1855 aged 67 / youngest daughter of the above / Sir James Watson and Johanna his wife /
