Eleanor, wife of E. N. Lewer 5th son of the founder died August 25th 1864, aged 67 /

Butler Adolphus Lewer 6th son of the founder died October 15th 1866 aged 64 /

William Henry Lewer 3rd son of the founder died December 15th 1871 aged 78 /

Edward Nathaniel Lewer 5th son of the founder died May 7th 1876 aged 80 /

Harriette Lewer, daughter of E. N. 5th son of the founder and Eleanor Lewer, died Sept. ... 1893 aged 68 /

Sacred to the memory of Mr. William Lewer / late of the Parish of St. George Hanover Square / who departed this life the 11th June 1798 aged 45 yrs /

Also Anne his widow who died 25 April 1812 / aged 72 years /
