Local History Collection (Deeds, 2c) shows that the deed in  
question was "Sealed and delivered (being first duly stampd)  
in the presence of Mordecai Hilton, James Mackclellan."

Presumably the James MacClennan (and other spelling) in the  
1762 Survey; he was then living near The King's Head (now  
The William IV).
