PARK, p. 347, gives the following information:

WMrs. Green was a Miss Wadham, and a descendant of the founders of Wadham College, Oxford; whose portraits, engraved by Faher, she kept hung up in the house. She married the late Mr. V. Green (of whom see a Memoir in the Monthly Mirror of June and July, 1809), an eminent mezzotinto engraver, author of a History of Worcester, in two vols. 4to. 1796, and a Review of the Polite Arts in France, 1782, 4to. and till lately Keeper of the British Institution in Pall Mail. Their son, Supert, who was brought up to his father's profession, and was partner with him in the unfortunate scheme for engraving the Dusseldorf Gallery, produced, before he was nine years old, a tragedy, called The Secret Plot, of which teme copies were printed for private distribution in 1777, 12mc."
