In memory of / Philadelphia / wife of Tysoe Saul Hancock / Whose Moral excellence united the / practice of every Christian virtue She bore / with pious resignation the severest trials of a / tedious and painful Malady and expired / on the 26 Feby 1792 aged 61 /

Also in memory of her grandson / Hastings only child of / Jean Capot Comt. de Feuillide / and of Elizabeth his wife / born 25 June 1786 died 9 Oct 1801 /

Also in memory of / Elizabeth wife of H. T. Austen Esq. formerly / widow of the Comt. Feuillide / A woman of Brilliant Generous & cultivated / mind just disinterested & charitable / she died after long & severe suffering / on the 25 Ap 1813 aged 50 / much regretted by the wise & good / & deeply lamented by the Poor /

1977: The first inscription can be made out, and a few words in the second, but the third has totally gone and the stone as a whole is nearly illegible.

1984: The whole of the above inscription has been obliterated, and the stone re-cut as follows:
