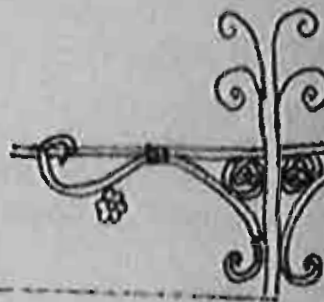
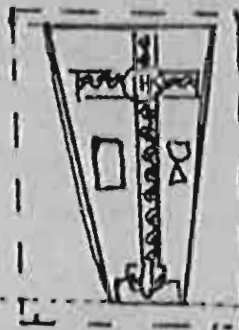

 Gothic lettering round edge.

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 763, tomb 462

Main inscription runs round south, east, north, west sides of stone:

Here lieth the body of the Revd. Thomas Ainger MA Prebendary /  
of St. Pauls, XXII / years incumbent of this parish who departed  
this life November / XV, MDCCCLXIII, aged LXIV + /

At east end, two small bronze plaques added:

To one who laboured heartily in the Church of Christ / this memorial  
 is placed by the Many who worked with / him and under him during his  
 Ministry in this Parish /

Frances, widow of Revd. Thomas Ainger / died at Eton January 30, 1871  
aged 71 years / buried at Ascot, Berks.
