

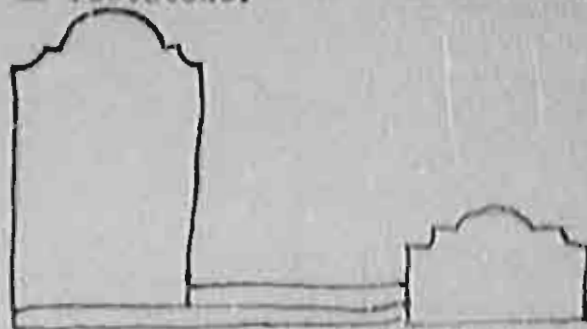

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward 596/254

Sacred to the memory of Henry Southey the dearly loved child of/
 Henry and Mary Ann Creed who died Sept. 11th 1861/
 Aged 4 years and 9 months/

Also of Mary Ann/Sister of the above/ died April 16th 1860/
 aged 15 months/interred in Kensal Green/

Also of Mary Ann Creed/ mother of the above/ and youngest daughter
 of William Southey of this Parish/who died Novr. 21st 1877 aged
 45 years/

Also of Henry Creed/husband of the above/who died in Paris
 Decr. 29th 1913/in his 89th year./

(The inscription on the earlier gravestone included after
 "Henry and Mary Ann Creed" the words "of 33 Conduit St.
Bond St. W." - Millward.

The new stone seems to have been placed there after the death of
 Henry Creed.)
