Here lyeth near the remains/of his worthy friend/Mr George Maybank/the body of Charles Chester/of Vere St Claremarket/Glazier/who departed this life 25 Ap 1767/Aged 59 yrs

NB Maybank grave not found, and not recorded by Millward but it could be XD 051, the illegible ledger nearby
