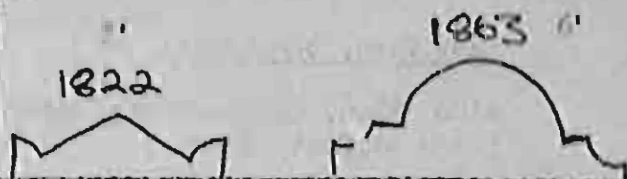

Sketch/Height

A double-size plot, overall 6'6" x 6'6"
 A small Portland headstone at the east end carries the earlier inscriptions, a larger Portland headstone at the west end carries the later ones. Kerb all round the plot; railings, now nearly disappeared.



INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 230, tomb 424

Small headstone, East face:

In memory of / George Stephen Hart / who died Dec. 11th 1822 Aged 30. /

Also Sarah wife of the above / who died July 7 1872 Aged 81. /

Also Four of their children who died in infancy. /

Large headstone, West face:

Sacred / to the memory of / Mr. George Hart, / A beloved husband and father, / who died Decr. 24th 1863 / aged 49. / He sleeps in Jesus. /

Also Anne Maria, / daughter-in-law of the above, / and the beloved wife of George Hart, / who entered into rest October 5th 1877, / aged 27 years. / Not lost but gone before. /

Also of Hannah Ellen, / widow of the above George Hart, / who fell asleep December 20th 1879, / aged 74 years. / She being dead yet speaketh. /

also Mary, daughter of the above, / who entered into rest August 6th 1891, / aged 47 years. / So he giveth his beloved sleep. /

Large headstone, East face:

Sacred / to the memory of / George Hart, / the dearly loved husband of Anne Hart, / who died Augt. 22nd 1912, aged 66. / Sleep on beloved, sleep and take thy rest, goodnight. /
