 In this long Course of Business / he Ornamented and Honoured his Profession /
 with well-known eminent Abilities and unblemished Integrity. / He departed /
 from the Cares of this World / on the 11th day of January 1773, / in the
 71st year of his Age, / leaving a numerous Family to lament their heavy
 Loss. / But with an Honest Fame he rests in Peace / awaiting a Joyful
 Resurrection to Life & Immortality /
