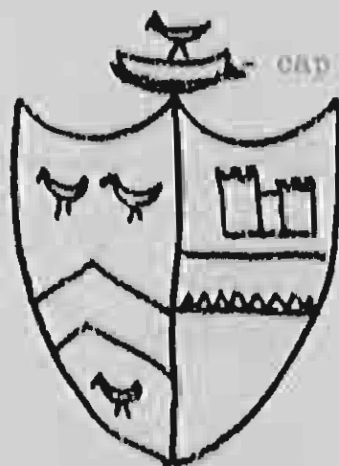
Low vault, with cap stone 6'0"

In a vault under this tomb / lie the remains of / Mr. John Hanson /  
late of the Parish of / St. Andrews Holborn Tea dealer / He was  
born at Wakefield in the / County of York the 11 Juny. 1748 /  
and Died in London June 26 1782.

Also of Penelope Hanson widow & relict of the above named John Hanson  
who departed this life at Woodford in the County of Essex on the 28  
September 1823 Aged 72 yrs.

Also of John Hanson their Eldest son who died in this Parish on the  
1st day of July 1805 aged 29 yrs.
