 Mrs. Rosetta Dawson / widow, / Daughter of George Watson of Hampstead / Died 9th April 1859 / Aged 73 Years.
 Mrs. Elizabeth Steele, / widow and sister of the above / who died 19th June 1869 / Aged 84 Years.

Miss Sarah Watson, / Daughter of Mr. Geo. Watson, / Ironmonger of this Parish / She died suddenly (sic) Nov. 19th 1795 / Aged 13 Years.

 Also of Mrs. Ann Watson / daughter in law of the above / who died March 29th 1817 / Aged 28 Years. / She was a tender Mother and a sincere Friend.
