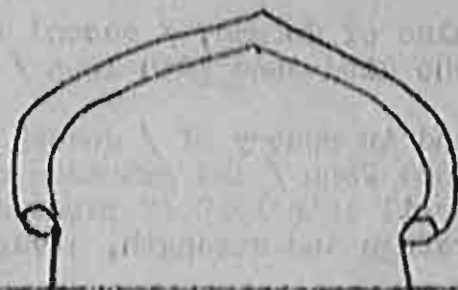

Millward p. 712, tomb 401

West face:

Sacred / to the memory of / Mr. Joseph Fenn Jnr. / the beloved husband
of / Mary Ann Fenn / a most kind and devoted husband, / a fond and
affectionate father, / who died on Oct. 9th 1851 / in the 32nd year of
his age. /

(In Millward's time there was a verse or quotation following, of which he gives this garbled version:-

'Lean not on health, twill pierce thee to the heart, a broken reed at
best but oft a spear on its sharp point peace bleeds and hope expires.'

Nothing of this now remains.)

Also Mr. Joseph Fenn, / father of the above / who departed this life
Oct. 7th 1862, / aged 69 years. /

Also Mrs. Rebecca Fenn, / widow of the above who died Jan'y 20th 1867
aged 73 years. (Now illegible.)

Also Rebecca aged 45 years and William aged 47 years, who both died
April 7th 1873, only daughter and 3rd son of the above Joseph and Rebecca
Fenn. (Now illegible.)
