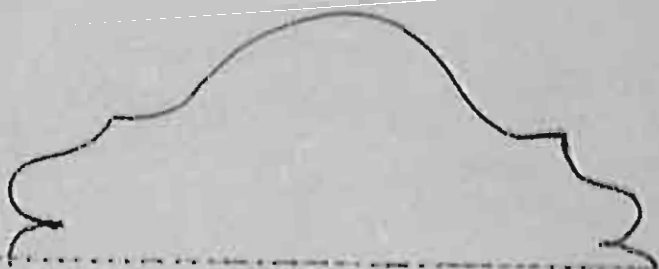

 and widow of the above who departed this life Feby. 15 1801 Aged 53 years.

Also of Mr. Richard Balm Husband of the above who departed this life  
 Oct. 31 1815 Aged 50 years.

Also of Mr. William Wiggins son of the above Richard Wiggins who  
 departed this life Nov. 25th 1830 Aged 50 years.
