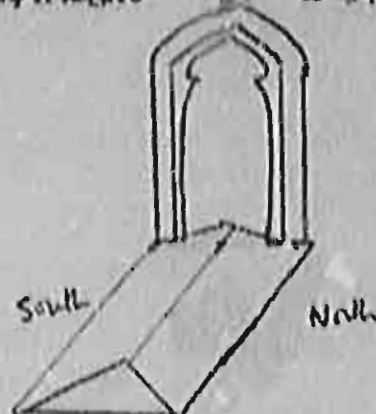

**SARAH**, his mother/

And on the 16th of March 1866/  
**SARAH SPANTON**,/ Mother of the above, aged 86 years./

**RHODA SUSAN PERKINS**,/ aged 34 years./
