Sketch/Height 1½'

Large plot, overall 9'0" x 6'0".
Marble kerb all round, possibly once had railings. Small double plinth at West end, with broken off (?) cross. Also smaller plinth at East end, with broken off (?) cross.

Ledger stone, 6'0" x 3'0", lying immediately to the West of this plot, and bearing no lettering at all, may be the entrance to a vault for the Lea family rather than another unrelated memorial.
