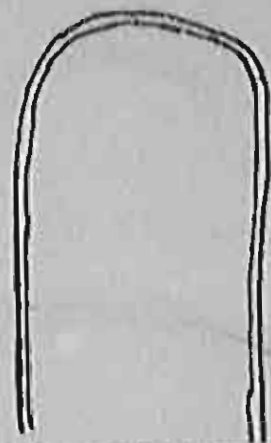

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward n. 706, tomb 3

The first two inscriptions are now flaked off; according to Millward they were:-

Sacred to the memory of William Willmott of this Parish who died Feby 7 1863 in the 68 yr of his age.

Also Mrs. Mary Ann Alexander Daughter of the above who died July 22 1866 aged 33 yrs.

Three more inscriptions, presumably all post-Millward, can be identified:-

/... also of Mary ... / ... wife of the ... / William Watson /

Also / William W.... / eldest son of ... / Born Octr. 20th 1825, d.... / and his wife Ma.... / Born Decr. 16th / Taken to rest Whitsunday M... 1907 / In her 86th year. / "He giveth quietn..... /
