

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 757, tomb 457

At West end, slab set in ground: Entrance / to / the family vault of / Basil G. Woodd.

On W. face of tomb, shield: three male torsos, couped, two over one, carrying clubs ; motto, Non Nobis. (Wild man of the Wood)

South side of tomb: Them which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

In affectionate memory of / Mary / for 49 years the beloved wife of Basil George Woodd of Hillfield Hampstead / she died 13th January 1864 aged 79.

Also of the above Basil George Woodd who died at Hillfield / 28th August 1872 / in the 22nd year of his age.

East end: To the loving memory of / Mary Bianca / second daughter of / Charles Henry Lardner Woodd / of Rosslyn House, Hampstead / born at Hampstead 4th June 1854 / married Theodore Bell 20th April 1881 / died at Epsom 30th May 1881 / where she is buried, aged 26 years /

North side: Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his Saints /

In loving memory of / Charles Henry Lardner Woodd / of Rosslyn House Hampstead and Oughtershaw Hall, Yorkshire, J.P. / born 18th Decemb 1821 died 15th December 1893 /
