INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS)

Millward 570/212

(North side) Beneath this stone in the hope of a blessed resurrection / lie the mortal remains of Eliza, wife of John Connor of Romney, who died in this parish on the 29th July, 1867. / Blessed are they whose hearts are pure in heart for they shall see God. Matt. V-8 / God is a refuge for us Ps XII 8

(South side) In memoriam John Connor / the loved and loving husband of her whose name is inscribed on this stone / and the much valued friend of many both in this country and in India.

(Millward recorded on the original stone: "I....John Connor, Chief Magistrate of Romney, who died at Alexandria on his return voyage on the 26th May 1824 and was buried in the Protestant Cemetery at Alexandria.....")
