Top (e. facing) \*\* In a vault underneath this Tomb / lieth interred the Body of / Mr. William Hart / late Citizen and Balter of London / who departed this life the 9th Day / of January 1717 Aged ..... /

\*\* Also the body of Mr. John Hart / father of the above said William Hart / Citizen and Mercer of London / who died the 3rd of July 1723 / in the 61st year of his age /

and the body of Mrs. Rebecca Hart / daughter of the above said John Hart / who died the ..... of March 17.. Etat 16 /

\* And the body of William Yorbury Esq. / who died September the 9th 1739 Aged ..... /

\* Robert Gary Esq. <sup>(sic)</sup> Piraniet Merchant / who died October 23rd 1751 aged 70 years /

Mrs. Amy Gary Relict of Robert Gary Esq. / died October the ... 1769 Aged 69 /

Also Miss Amy Cary / died August 12th 1756 aged 17 / Universally lamented.

South side Also Miss Amy Cary / Died August 12 1756 aged 17 / universally lamented

North side Robert Gary Esq. / Died VI of April 1722 aged 49 years.

\*(It seems likely that "Piraniet" is a mason's error for "Virginia".)  
 \* Millward records only last 2 deaths; nothing on top.
