

Tyler was Master of the Stationers' Company, 1672 (1908)

Lyaons quotes from the Burial Register:

"Mr Evan Tyler (Prince Tyler so called) a printer was buried  
Dec 15, 1682."

Park (p. 307) quotes Le Neve for full inscription, which begins  
"Mors mihi luorum", gives the surname as TYTLER, names the  
executors as "Henry Teonge, Clerke, Nicholas Hardinge and  
Wm Miller", and dates the tomb on 12 February 1683.
