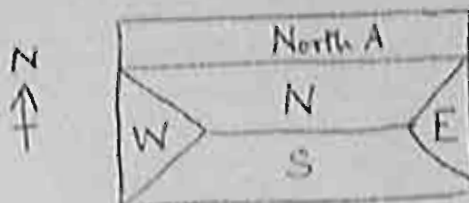

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) **Millward 476/ 100**

North Here lie the remains of Miss Ann Brooks / daughter of William and Ann Brooks / who departed this life December 16 1798 / in the 3rd year of her age

Also / the remains of Mr William Brooks / father of the above / Miss Ann Brooks / who departed this life July 15 1803 aged 32 years

North A Here are also deposited the remains of / Mrs Louisa Ann Brooks / daughter of the above William Brooks / who departed this life 3 April 1848 aged 45 years

East (Taken from Millward) Henry / son of William and Ann Brooks died 29 March 1832 aged 34

South Master Charles Brooks / son of Henry and Matilda Brooks / died January . 4 1818 aged 11 months and 6 days

Frederic Brooks / died 27 July 1820 aged 44 days

Ellen Ann Brooks died May 15 1822 / aged 8 months and 27 days

West Matilda Brooks died August 1 1831 in the 13 year of her age
