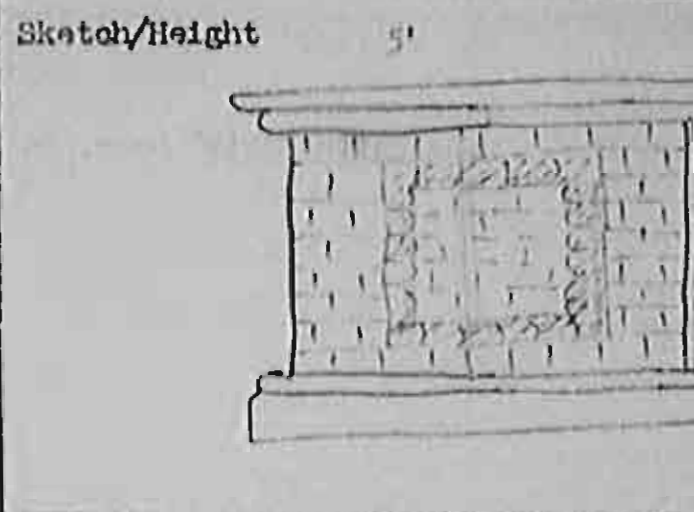

DESCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward 478/102 & 103

Identified by location in Millward, by Duchterlony connection by traces of long MI, by Millward calling it 'Altar', and by the few legible words, underlined in black. Inscription taken entirely from Millward.

(Altar) Here lies the body of Elizabeth Shuter / who departed this life / 15 November 1727 / in the 10 year of her age

Erected by order of Alexander Duchterlony of London Merchant in memory of his dearly beloved wife / Margaret heiress at law to / the family of Hart and Yarbury / of this parish

whose monument is erected at their own choice near to this / She died at Richmond on the 22 March 1753 aged 55 / Of life and manners most unblamable /

Here also lie the remains of her dear friend Katherine SHUTCH / of an ancient family in Staffordshire / lovely and sweet in their lives / and in their death were not divided /

Also Mrs Ann RICHARDS died Oct 23 / 1763 aged 70
