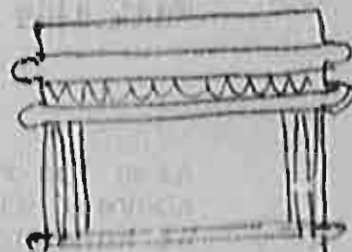

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward 522/153

N. side Sacred to the memory of / Jonathan Key Esq / who died March 12 1805 / in the 69 year of his age

With that meekness and resignation / which marked his faith in Christ / and his hope of a blessed resurrection

Also of Jonathan Henry Key Esq / second son of the above who died April 30 1838 in the 68 year of his age

Also of Elizabeth the wife of the above Jonathan Henry Key Esq / (who died 14 July 1838 aged 56 - Millward)

S. side Elizabeth / wife of Jonathan Key Esq / and daughter of John and Elizabeth Garrett / of Weston in Staffordshire / died February 25 1818 in her 76 year

Exemplary in the duties of a wife and mother / amiable in every relative situation / and particularly attentive to the distressed she placidly sunk into the vale of years / universally beloved and respected (sic)

Sarah only daughter of the above named Jonathan and Elizabeth Key / died 23 April 1840 aged 72 years

East side Kingsmill Key / the second son of John Key Esq / of Denmark Hill Camberwell / died April 24 1819 aged 21 years
