Sacred to the memory of / George Harvey Esq / who died October 24 1801 / aged 53 years

Charles Harvey / son of the above / died August 1801 aged 6 weeks

Mary Ann Harvey daughter of the above / died January 16 1804 aged 9 years and 8 months

William Thomas and Edward Harvey / sons of the above died infants

Also of Mrs Mary Ann relict of the above / George Harvey Esq and wife of James Abel Esq of this parish / died May 3 1816 aged 53 years

Also of the above James Abel Esq / died June 17 1817 aged 55 years

This vault contains also the remains of / Mrs Mary Parrett the attached and faithful / servant of the above Mrs Abel for 22 years / died February 1813 aged 47 years
