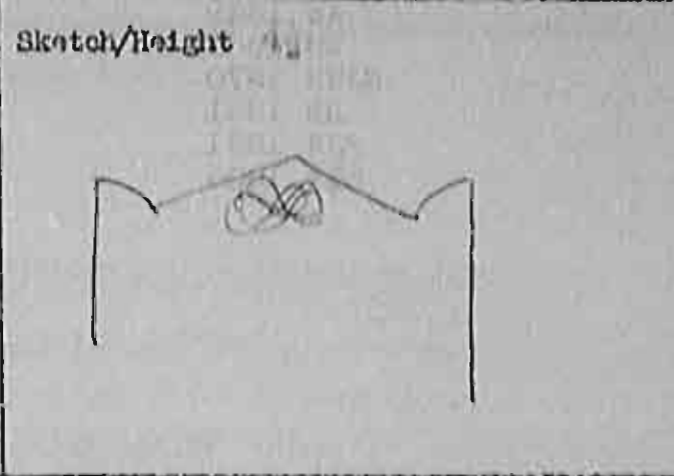

Sacred to the memory of / Mrs Ann HEGGS / who died  
 20th day of January 1837 / in the 55 year of her age  
  
 Also two of her children / Sarah and Joseph / who died in  
 their infancy  
  
 In peace I lay me down to rest  
 The Lord of life has conquered death  
 From sin and guilt has set me free  
 I hope to be (sic) in the same for thee  
  
 Also of her Ann HEGGS / wife of Mr John HEGGS /  
Blessed Victim / who died 17 Nov 1837 / in her 60th year  
  
 Also of William HEGGS / of the Free Mason /  
Victim / who died 27th Dec 1837 / in his 60th year  
  
 He died about a year  
  
 Also Sarah HEGGS / daughter of the above /  
 who died 17 Nov 1837 / in her 60th year  
  
 Also Joseph HEGGS / son of the above / who died  
 in his infancy
