

Top Slab (west facing) Here lyeth the body of Mr William Snoxell of this Parish / who departed this life the 9th day of / October 1748 aged 67 /  
 Here also lyeth the body of / Isabella Snoxell wife of / Edward Snoxell died the / 14 November 1761 / in the 53 year of her age

Edward Snoxell / died April 22 1766 aged 70  
Armine Snoxell / died May 29 1764 aged 28  
Mrs Susannah Foster died January ye 28 1784 aged 45 years  
 Also / Mr John Foster died October 7 1780 aged 69 years

West side (1) Sacred to the memory of / Captain Thomas Houlditch / of His Majesty's Navy son of Richard and Mary / Houlditch lost in the East Indies 1780  
 Also to the memory of / Captain Henry Houlditch of the Queen's 8th Regiment / son of Richard and Mary Houlditch who / died in the West Indies of the yellow / Fever April 14 1793
