DESCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward 727d (p. 1009)

Millward calls this "indistinct" and makes no attempt to record it; in fact the name can be made out, as follows:

Mrs. Esther Frith Wife (?) ...../ four more lines illegible.

Lycens v. 539 has a Lt James FRITH (1771) and a longish inscription for a Lt John FRITH (1788):

'Upon his tomb is this singular inscription, under an emblematical device represent a rainbow, beneath which is the sun within a double triangle: "And there shall be a standard of Truth erected in the west, which shall overpower the enemy." \_\_\_\_\_ May 12, 1786, "This glorious phenomena in God of the Almighty came down for my protection in latitude 15, on the Bahama Sandbanks, and where the spiritual cities of Sodom and Gomorrah came up in the West Indian. Vide Revelations. Your dying labors shall again revive, the phoenix souls of Friths are still alive."
