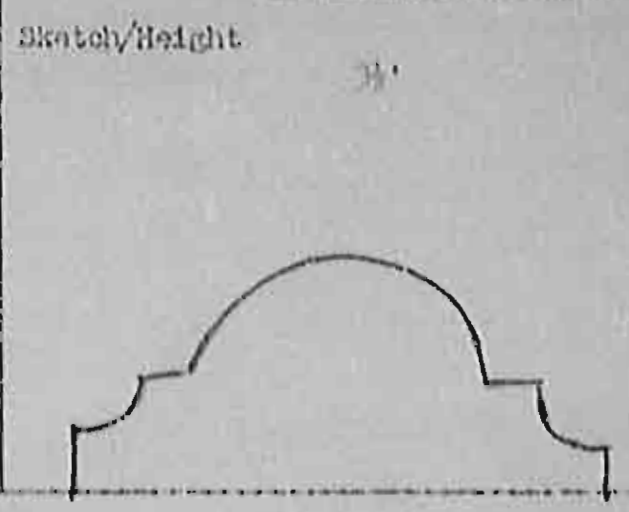


Main Surname BRITTAIN Area Old churchyard

Sacred / to the memory of / George Brittain / of West End Green
 in this parish / died the 21st of March 1863 / aged 42 years /

Also / George Arthur / grandson of the above / died the 16th Novr.
 1872 / aged 4 years 10 months / "His soul pleased the Lord therefore
 hastened he / to take him away" /

Also Jane Brittain / widow of the above / who died September 18th
 1876 / aged 55 years / in life respected in death lamented /

Also Jane / married daughter of the above / who died September 29th
 1903 / aged 54 years /
