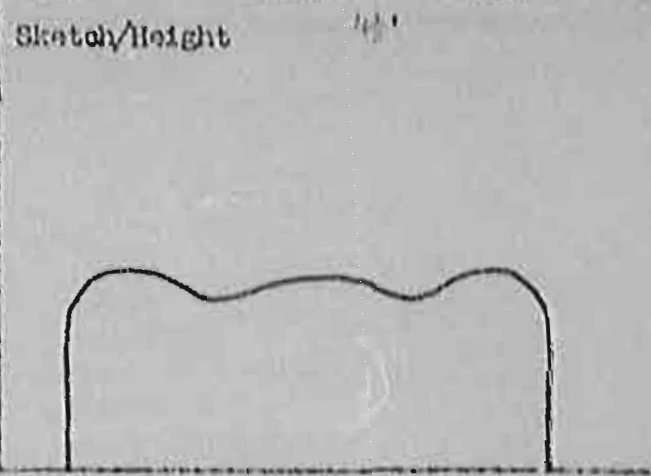

Here lies the body of Mrs Sarah BRIND wife of Mr John BRIND of this parish who departed this life the 30th day of March 1766 aged - years

Also the above said Mr John BRIND who departed this life the 27th day of November 1767 aged 65 years

Also Mary JENNINGS daughter of J and H JENNINGS died April 20 and 1775 aged 35 years

Ann JENNINGS died 11th May 1774 aged 2 years and 6 weeks

East face

Here lieth the remains of Mrs Mary BRIND wife of Mr Henry BRIND who departed this life the 10th 1771 aged 55 years
