West face

Time stops for no man / loving husbands and dearest friends / as you pass by / remember in the dust you must lie / these worldly gains you must leave behind / and perhaps like me be cut off in your prime / weep not for me for tis in vain / for God thought fit to ease my pain / (All this verse now eroded away.)
