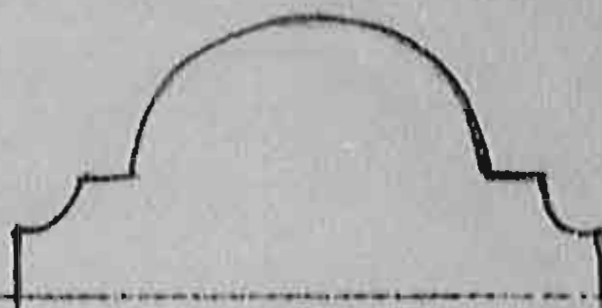

In memory / of / Richard Martin / of this parish / who departed this life April 27th 1859 / in the 75th year of his age /

Also of Mary Martin wife of the above / who departed this life Novr. 26th 1859 / aged 76 years /

Also of Walpole Martin / second son of the above / who departed this life July 31st 1855 / aged 44 years /

Also of Henry Martin / third son of the above / who departed this life April 27th 1862 / aged 48 years /

Also of Mary Anne Martin / who departed this life Novr. 24th 1866 / aged 57 years /

Also of James Martin / son of the above / who departed this life January 9th 1890 / aged 74. . /

Also of Emma CHANT / niece of the above / who departed this life November 4th 1805 / aged (76?) years /
