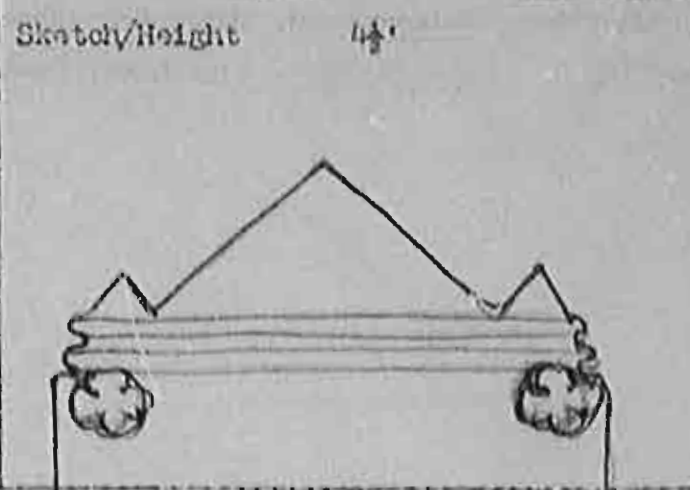

Also of Mrs. Sarah Cook / mother of the above Elizth. Mary Ware / who died December 29th 1848 / aged 68 years /

Behold he taketh away who can hinder him? / who will say unto him what doest thou? /

Also Mr. Robert Cook / husband of the above Mrs. Sarah Cook / who died April 20th 1856 aged 72 years /
