DESCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 98/9, tomb 705

(Millward omitted the inscriptions to the Cook family on the East face of this stone, and recorded only GLEWS on the West face.)

East face

To / the Memory of / Mr. John Cook / victualler / late of this Parish / who died July 12th 1813 / Aged -- Years /

Also three of their children / who died in their infancy /

Also of / John William Cook / Son of the above / who died January / Aged 9 Years and months /

Also of / Harriet Glews Cook / Daughter of the above / who died / (last three lines of this inscription illegible)

West face

To/the Memory of / Mr. William Glews / who died January 28th 1849 / aged 75 Years /

Footstone: In 1881 the footstone still existed somewhere close by, and Millward recorded it separately as No. 701 in his book; it then read:

W.G.	1849
J.G.	1813
J.W.G.	1823
H.G.G.	1824
A.G.	1856
