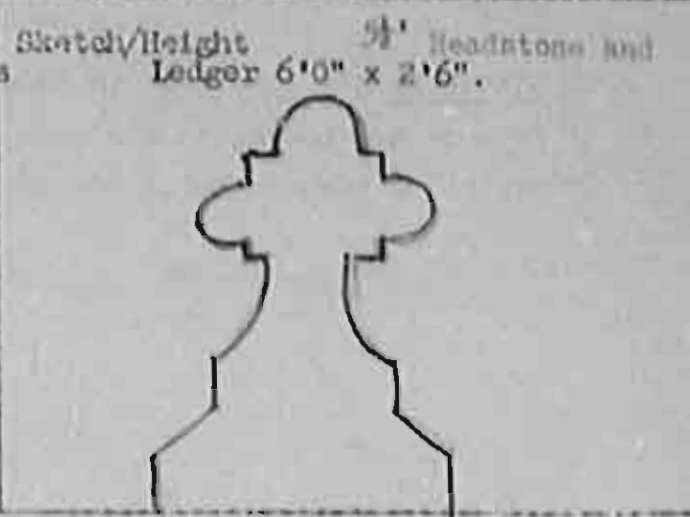

 died 23rd November 1849 / aged 5 years /
 Also of / William youngest brother of the above / who died 28 June
 1853 / aged 15 weeks /
 Also of / Mary Coates / mother of the above / Christopher Joseph Coates /
 who died 7th September 1859 / aged 82 years /
 Also of William Coates / husband of the above / who was interred in the
 adjoining / burial ground on 24th November 1826 /
 (Two monograms: CM divide the last inscription centrally)
 CW
 (2) East face of headstone:
 In / loving memory / of / John Coates / third son of Christopher Joseph /
 and Elizabeth Coates / who died March 21st 1882 / aged 32 years / Wait
 on the Lord: be of good courage and he shall / strengthen thine heart /
 wait, I say, on the Lord / Psalm XXVII Ver. XIV /
 Also / Elizabeth Coates / for 61 years the beloved wife of / Christopher
 Joseph Coates / who departed this life on 14th October 1905 / aged 87 years
 Also the above named / Christopher Joseph Coates / who departed this life
 on 16th October 1905 aged 85 years / "In their death they were not divided."
