

INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or FS) Millward p. 561, tomb 680

In memory of Sarah Nowell late wife of Thos Nowell of the Parish of St. Sepulchre London died Dec the 9 1758 in the 45th year of her age.

Also of the following grandchildren John Clark died May 18th 1765 aged 9 months & 22 days.

Thomas Nowell Clark Nov 17 1765 aged 3 mon & 4 days.

- Clark May 10th 1767 aged 4 mon & 6 days.

Sarah Clark Nov 14 1769 aged 6 yrs 3 mon & 4 days.

And also of Charles Wear Clark the eldest son of the said Thomas & Sarah Clark who departed this life the 3 of April 1801 aged 31.

Here lieth Sarah late wife of Thomas Clark & daughter of Thomas & Sarah Nowell of Snow Hill London ob 25 Aug 1779 AEtat 37. A dutifull daughter & affectionate Wife Under Mother & Sincere Friend.

Here lie the remains of Mr. Thomas Clark Snow Hill London Builder Died May 28 1792 aged 71 yrs.
