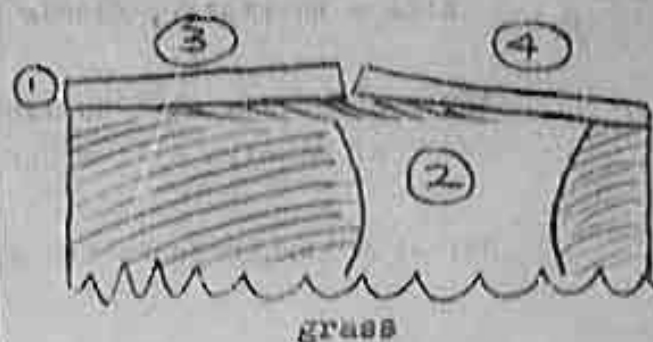

1. Family Vault of H. Cooper Rose M.D. of Hampstead
2. (In M)emory of / ..A / ...ead, who died May 28 1881 aged 56 /  
 (H)er Price is far above Rubies / (She stretcheth out her hand  
 to the poor; yea, she reacheth forth her hands to the needy /  
 (She looketh well to the ways of her household) and eateth not  
 the bread of idleness / (Her children arise up and call her  
 blessed; her husband also and he praiseth her / Prov. 31,  
 verses 10, 20, 27, 28
3. Sacred to the Memory of / William Herbert Rose / who died  
 September 21 1881 / aged 18
4. Henry Cooper Rose M.D. / Surgeon Major and of the Middle Temple /  
 Barrister at Law / who practised as a physician in Hampstead /  
 for more than 40 years / He died 1 July 1914 aged 83 /  
 Also Henry Cooper / Eldest son of the above / Born 1858  
 died 1917
