Mallist Esq / of this parish / with whom she lived nearly 25 years / Rev XIV. 13
 Also of / Joseph Sparkes / 15 years gardener in the same family / and for 32 years householder / in this parish who died suddenly / May 23 1850 aged 61 years / Matt 25.21 / Also Jane Slee / who died Dec 27 1874 / who after long and faithful service / in the family of John Merivale Esq / retired on her own means and lived to the age of 90 / respected by all / Mine age is as nothing before thee
