

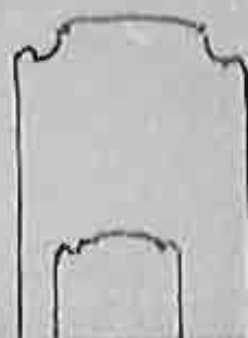

 amiable and much lamented child // Fell a victim
 to that cruel disease the measles // which closed thus
 early a life of much promise.
 It has pleased the Almighty to call her //
 From this Vale of Tears to the Mansions of Bliss //
 We must therefore in dutiful resignation to his //
 will Cease to mourn her loss // Yet whilst memory lends
 its seal // She will still live in the heart // of her
 fond Parents & deeply afflicted family.

PS Born May 5th 1809 Died 16 March 1818.
 E.P. 1818.
