## DESCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, or PS)

NB: The Nevinson family have erected three headstones in two spaces, D.1 and D.2, with a kerb linking all three gx into one square plot. Kerb also bears further inscriptions, at foot of plot. Grass in centre. Earlier footstone now gone. Millward No. 307, p. 262, for Emma, Jane and Charlotte only.

Inscriptions W. face:

To the memory of / Emma Nevinson / second daughter of the late / Edward Henry Nevinson Esq. / of this Parish / Died March 12th 1853 / Aged 37 years / Them wh. sleep in Jesus will bring with him (sic Millward). Also of / Jane Nevinson / Elder daughter of the above / Edward Henry Nevinson Esq. / who died May 11th 1868 / Aged 56 years. / Also of Charlotte Sarah Nevinson / widow of the above / Edward Henry Nevinson Esq. / who died May 30th 1868 / Aged 82 years. / In their death they were not divided.

E.N. 1853 / J.N. 1868 / C.S.N. 1868 (This no longer visible anywhere).

Also of / Maria Jane / the beloved wife of / George Henry Nevinson, of Leicester / and eldest daughter of Basil George Woodd, of this parish / born August 29th 1817, died July 4th 1867 / Her children rise up and call her blessed / her husband also and he praiseth her.

 Elisabeth Sarah Nevinson / 1848 - 1922 /  
 Mary Sophia Nevinson / 1847 - 1933 /
