- (1) Charlotte Sarah: Co-founder, with Mrs. Hears, of the
Hampstead Clothing Club for the Poor (pp. 26/7). "Would
wait at a stile at the top of Heloise Avenue to meet her
husband on his return in the evening from London." (p. 40).
- (2) Elizabeth Sarah and Miss Anna Sharpe started Penny Bank
in Oriel Place, 1879. pp. 25/6.
- (3) Mary Sophia born Sydney Cottage, Rosalyn Hill (then Red
Lion Hill) and from nursery window could see cows milked
at corner of modern Thurlow Road - used to be small pond
there. (Sydney, St. Anne's, and Elm Cottages built 1813
next to house with balcony on south corner of Pilgrim's
Lane.) Helped her grandmother Charlotte with Clothing
Club as a child. pp. 27, 40, 42, 45-47.
