Also of the above / Edward Henry Nevinson Esq. / who died on the 4th August 1856 / Aged 71 years

And also of / Edward Henry Nevinson / who died on the 11th January 1852 / in the 2nd year of his age / Son of Edward Nevinson Eldest son of / the above Edward Henry Nevinson.

Jesus said, suffer the little children to come unto me and forbid them not, for of such is the kingdom of heaven.

And of the said / Edward Nevinson Esq. / of this Parish and of Lincoln's Inn / Barrister at law / who died on the 11th May 1852 in the 39th year of his age / Thanks be to God who giveth us that victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Footstone had initials: H.N. 1825 / .E.H.N. 1856 / E.H.N. 1852 / E.N. 1852 but no longer extant.
