

(1) Edward Henry, enr., married to Charlotte Sarah; family came to Hampstead soon after 1800 (Hampstead in Light and Shade, Mary Hill, (pub. John Ball Sons & Carnow Ltd., 1933). Was Paymaster of the Exchequer (Streets of Hampstead, p. 41). 1819, ~~ix~~ requests additional lamp near his new house on Red Lion Hill. 1837, p. 4., "Owners of Property & Proxies" - Roslyn Street. (local history references, Swiss Cottage.)

(2) Edward, son of above, lived at Sydney Cottage, Roslyn Hill (M. Hill, op.cit., p. 47).
