 who died February 17th 1826 / Aged 4 years & 4 months

Also of Ionisa (?) / sister of the above / who died February 10th 1827 /
 aged 15 months

Also of Mr. John Watts / grandfather of the above / who died April 29th 1828 /
 Aged 46 years

Also of Thomas Nevill / who died August 7th 1828 / Aged 29 years

Also of Sarah Priscilla Nevill / who died August 17th 1828 / Aged 4 years &
 8 months

Also of Mrs. Sarah Watts / who died August 8th 1840 / Aged 61 years.
