

Sir John SCOTT (1841-1904) KCMG, DCL, 'sometimes Judge of the High Court of Bombay, Judicial Adviser to H.H. the Khedive of Egypt, Deputy Judge Advocate General to R.H. Foreign ...'

His wife Edgeworth (1842-1924), named after Maria Edgeworth, was a niece of Sir Rowland Hill, the postal reformer; Sir John was also linked to the Hill family through his sister and stepmother.
