INSCRIPTIONS (refer to Millward, position on sketch, o. PS)

Inscription on E. face: In loving memory of / Dear Little / Bertie, / the beloved son of / Philip & Alice Thres, / who fell asleep Jan. 12th, 1888 / aged 2 years & 7 months / and of Dorothy Alice, / died July 20th 1890, aged 4 months.

Inscription on S. face: and of / Philip / died Sept. 13th 1893 / aged 32 years the beloved husband of / Alice Thres.

Inscription on W. face: In ever Loving Memory of / Philip / the dearly beloved / and devoted husband of Emma Thres: / who passed peacefully away Novr. 13th 1909 / aged 76 years / also of Emma, wife of the above, / who died April 4th 1921.

(N.B. Hill's list shows the name as TRES, and gives only Bertie, Dorothy and Emma; furthermore, Bertie's date is incorrectly given as 1838.)

It also shows Mrs. Catherine GREEN, 1825, as being buried in the Bay of Row D. However, she and several other Greens are in plot D 11.
